The European Research Centre of Small Agricultural Holdings at the University of Agriculture in Krakow is organising its 5th International Scientific Conference. This year's topic is "Alternative Sources of Income for Small Agricultural Holdings in the European Union".

The topic of alternative sources of income in agriculture, specifically in small agricultural holdings undertaken this year, is very much current and uniquely important on the entire area of the European Union, and also in other countries of Europe and the world. - EU agricultural policy and the domestic policies of supporting small agricultural holdings,
  - institutional forms of supporting entrepreneurship,
  - agricultural and rural unemployment,
  - entrepreneurship among the rural youth
- agricultural education and consultancy as well as rural consultancy in problem solving the problems
  - of unemployment and supporting entrepreneurship,
  - the transfer of knowledge and innovation into agricultural practices.

The list of problems that we will take up at the conference is open. We hope that these will be significant issues in the development of alternative sources of income in your countries and regions and also topics being in your academic or professional fields of interest. The conference will be held in Polish and English.

We will gladly and quickly publish selected papers (upon fulfilment of the editorial requirements) in our quarterly entitled: "Problems of Small Agricultural Holdings".
